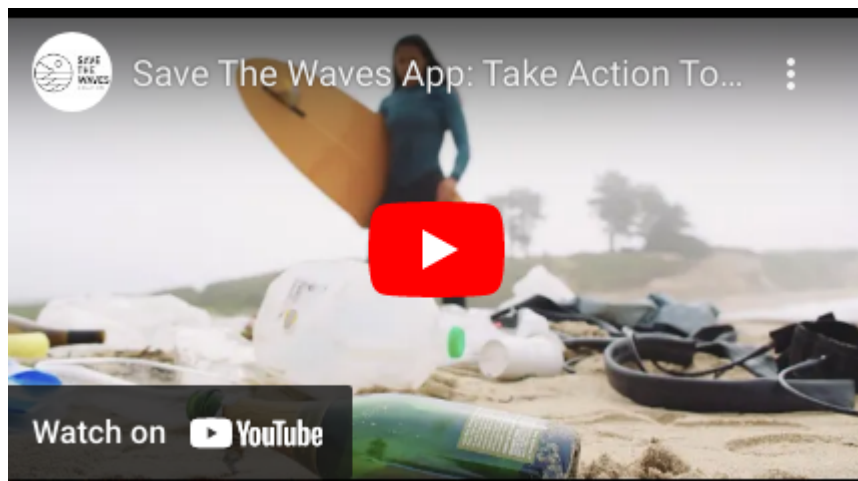

The [Save The Waves App](#) is a tool that crowdsources information from beach-goers and coastal users around the world about environmental issues or threats present in their coastline. The goal of this App is to connect individual reports with Save The Waves' growing [network of partners](#) on the ground, and globally, to take action on the issues reported. In addition, a user-facing 'take action' button on the App allows users to go one step beyond reporting and potentially organize a solution to the threat among their community with the tools partners provide. We believe that this tool can be leveraged by the Deep Network in the process of educating individuals about ocean issues (learning by doing) as well as by providing an easy first step to contribute to the health of coastal ecosystems around the world.
